

Project	MedAlert
Idea leader	Laurentiu Diaconu Colintineanu
Idea description	Reporting corruption in the health system through a mobile app and an SMS service. The information goes straight to CNAS Corp Control, and media would receive reports on regular basis. The status of the corruption cases would also be available for users, which would put real pressure on CNAS to take real measures. It remains to be seen if the identity of those asking for bribe is made public.
Identified problem	Corruption is generalized in the health system and, with very few exceptions, the only way to get medical assistance, in spite of all the taxes we pay. No reporting means the authorities cannot react. A platform to report corruption would warn other patients about the "fees" and would enable authorities to respond.
Solution	Mobile app and SMS reporting system that would automatically send reports to authorities.

Project	Dispari.ro
Idea leader	Oana Dan
Idea description	Platform to help citizens fight against acts of corruption. The website will feature all the steps to be followed, documents necessary to be sent to anticorruption authorities. The corruption acts will be reported using a mobile app.
Identified problem	1 in 3 Romanians admit to having bribed someone and reporting is discouraged by a lack of efficient tools and the "I don't matter" mentality. We need a platform that gives people easy access to reporting tools and that gathers and puts these reports on a map.
Solution	a website and a mobile app that gives easy access to report forms on the public institutions' websites and also centralizes all these reports.



Project	Cine Ce a Promis
Idea leader	Madalina Mocan, Nicoleta Chiriță, Paul Roman
Idea description	The platform to collect all politicians promises in times of campaigns and estimate the cost of the pledges. The website will allow citizens to give their input and debate on the priorities of local communities.
Identified problem Identified Solution	Politicians make many promises during pre-elections and most of the time they are unrealistic, as post-elections show, when they cannot fulfill them. We need a platform that puts together these promises, evaluates their costs and inform the citizens about how realistic they are, so they can make informed decisions. A platform where people can register, can bring proof of the politicians' promises and can debate whether they kept them or not. The platform can later on unite voters to find a way to remind the politicians what they said.

Project	Harta Zonelor Despădurite
Idea leader	Liana Buzea, Eco Assist
Idea description	A map of deforestation in Romania made by analyzing satellite images. It would give us an idea about the proportions of this phenomenon, direct environmental organizations to the areas that most need help, most importantly, it would point towards those responsible, by a simple match with the records of the forest owners.
Identified problem	Illegal deforestations impact the environment, the communities and the health of the ecosystems, leading to land slides and catastrophic floods. We need a platform to monitor deforestations through satellite images and to report them to authorities.
Solution	A platform with an easy to update database that has the possibility to send reports to the authorities and to put together reports from the field send by a mobile app.



Project	Civic SOS
Idea leader	Ela Iliesi
Idea description	Social platform that allows citizens to report to authorities law infringements and corruption acts by using a mobile app linked directly to the state service that can solve the specific problem.
Identified problem	Romanians have a diminished civic participation – they seldom get involved in preventing crime, even if they could, for fear of consequences. But if there was a place where they could easily report a crime they witnessed, they would use it.
Solution	A mobile app that sends reports to authorities.

Project	Bani Pierduţi
Idea leader	Elena Calistru
Idea description	Platform to centralize all public financial information (public budgets, annual balance sheets) of projects with public funding. The aim is to make authorities more aware of the way they spend public money.
Identified problem	We pay taxes, but we don't know how they are spent. We need a platform that follows the money so people understand where they are going and authorities are more responsible.
Solution	A platform that gathers public information from the authorities' website and can generate a map of public spending.



Project	Democracy Online
Idea leader	Mircea Zachia
Idea description	A platform that would enable citizens to engage effectively in the law-making process.
Identified problem	Romanians don't get involved in the political decision-making process. We need a platform that motivates them and allows them to submit legal initiatives.
Solution	A platform where citizens can register, submit ideas and initiatives and vote. Volunteers can get the necessary signatures so that the most popular ideas make it to the Parliament.

Project	Orasul Meu
Idea leader	Monica Ipate and Razvan Beschea
Idea description	A platform to enable users regain their public space by uploading pictures of inappropriate things happening in their cities (in particular cars parked on grass or sidewalk), and reacting to them. This project started from an interest in freeing the sidewalks and helping find decent parking. We want to regain the sidewalks and paths through non-violent methods of ridicule and awareness of bad habits.
Identified problem	There is very little public space and often the paths and sidewalks are blocked by cars. We want to create communication channels between our needs and the local authorities.
Solution	Based on a map of public parking, users signal free spaces but will be able to express frustration when blocked by a car. The application stores registration numbers of cars parked illegally, city, area, time and a picture to verify.



Project	Bursa Şpăgilor
Idea leader	Codru Vrabie
Idea description	Platform to enable citizens to report how much they paid for a public free service. The aim is to measure and lower the level of corruption in the public administration, until it collapses entirely.
Identified problem	1 in 3 Romanians admits to having offered bribe. Information about the "price" of a certain service is transferred in an informal manner, which allows those who ask for bribe to change the value all the time. We need a map where the "prices" are disclosed, which will allow people to choose the "cheapest" services. In time, this will lead to the elimination of bribery.
Solution	A dynamic platform where you can compare the prices of various bribes and show places where you don't need to pay any.
