



September 2013 compared with August 2013

## Euro area and EU28 production in construction down by 1.3%

In September 2013 compared with August 2013, seasonally adjusted production in the construction<sup>1</sup> sector fell by 1.3% in both the **euro area<sup>2</sup>** (EA17) and the **EU28<sup>2</sup>**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In August 2013<sup>3</sup>, production in construction rose by 0.3% and 0.2% respectively.

In September 2013 compared with September 2012<sup>4</sup>, production in construction declined by 0.2% in the **euro area** and increased by 0.2% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for September 2013, production in construction fell in nine and rose in six. The largest decreases were observed in **Portugal** (-12.3%), **Romania** (-6.9%) and the **Czech Republic** (-4.6%), and the highest increases in **Slovenia** (+6.2%), **Slovakia** (+1.6%) and **Hungary** (+0.8%).

Building construction fell by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 1.1% in the **EU28**, after -0.2% in both zones in August 2013. Civil engineering decreased by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 2.6% in the **EU28**, after +0.8% and +0.7% respectively in the previous month.

## Annual comparison

Among the Member States for which data are available for September 2013, production in construction fell in nine, remained stable in **Slovakia** and rose in five. The largest decreases were registered in **Portugal** (-14.9%), the **Czech Republic** (-11.8%), **Slovenia** (-7.9%) and **Italy** (-6.1%), and the highest increases in **Hungary** (+9.3%), **Spain** (+6.1%) and the **United Kingdom** (+4.9%).

Building construction dropped by 0.1% in the **euro area** and increased by 1.1% in the **EU28**, after -1.1% and +0.7% respectively in August 2013. Civil engineering fell by 0.9% in the **euro area** and by 3.8% in the **EU28**, after -2.2% and -3.7% respectively in the previous month.

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

The annual growth rates have been revised from -4.7% to -1.3% for the euro area and from -2.5% to -0.2% for the EU28.
